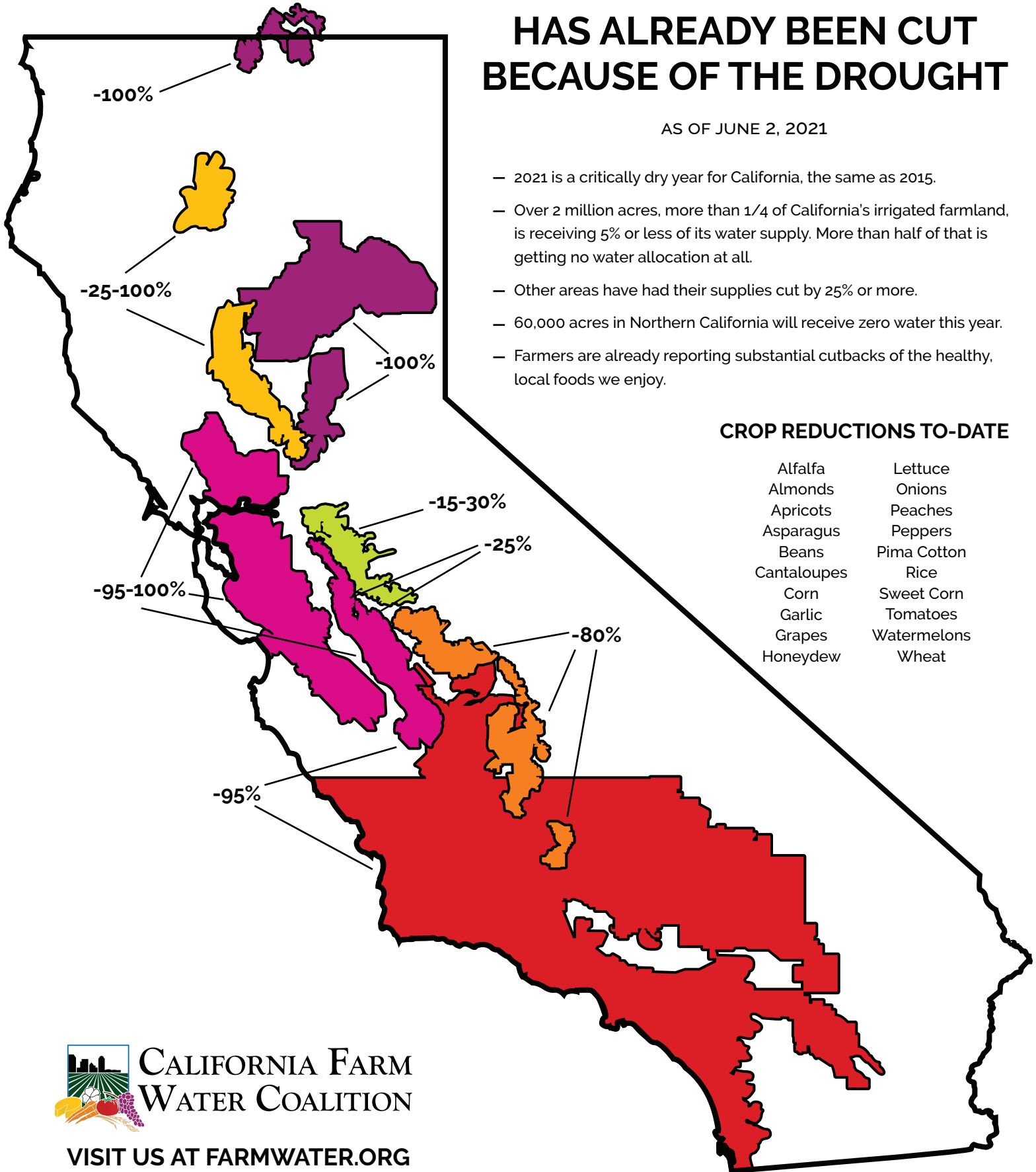


FARM WATER HAS ALREADY BEEN CUT BECAUSE OF THE DROUGHT

AS OF JUNE 2, 2021

- 2021 is a critically dry year for California, the same as 2015.
- Over 2 million acres, more than 1/4 of California's irrigated farmland, is receiving 5% or less of its water supply. More than half of that is getting no water allocation at all.
- Other areas have had their supplies cut by 25% or more.
- 60,000 acres in Northern California will receive zero water this year.
- Farmers are already reporting substantial cutbacks of the healthy, local foods we enjoy.
